Disclosure of Information to Others

All of this information will be treated as confidential and will not be disclosed to others without your authorization, except to the extent necessary for the conduct of our business and not contrary to any law. For example, Aetna Life Insurance Company may also release information in its file to its reinsurer(s) and to other life insurance companies to whom you may apply for coverage, or to whom a claim for benefits may be submitted. Your Right of Access & Correction
